Members expressed concerns over the nearness to the Millfield Footpath, Overdevelopment of the site and this being back land development which the Parish Council does not support.

Proposed Object on the above 3 grounds by Councillor Greenacre, Seconded Councillor Russell - Agreed Unanimous.
