

GREAT YARMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

B Y E L A W

made under the provisions of Section 9 Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, by the Council of the Borough of Great Yarmouth for the purpose of preventing people from parking certain types of vehicle on the car parks on certain of the Council's housing estates.

1. No person shall park or leave a vehicle whether mechanically propelled or not which has an unladen weight exceeding two decimal point five tons on or at any of the areas of land specified in the Schedule to these byelaws.
2. Any person offending against the byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Fifty pounds.

SCHEDULE

Areas of land to which this byelaw relates:-

1. The car park with parking places for six cars on the west side of St Hugh's Green on the Council's housing development at Crow Hall, Wadham Road, Gorleston-on-Sea, Norfolk (which area of land is shown edged with a red line on plans which may be inspected at the Town Hall, Great Yarmouth).

2. The five car parks which adjoin Laburnum Road on the Council's housing development at Shrublands, Gorleston-on-Sea aforesaid (which five areas of land are shown edged with red lines on plans which may be inspected at the Town Hall, Great Yarmouth).
