Notes from the Licensing Act 2003 in order to help complete the form.

1. **Condition 1 in section 62(2)** – under the rules of the club persons may not
 - a) be admitted to membership, or
 - b) be admitted, as candidates for membership, to any of the privileges of membership,
 without an interval of at least two days between their nomination or application for membership and their admission.

2. **Condition 2 in section 62(3)** – under the rules of the club persons becoming members without prior nomination or application may not be admitted to the privileges of membership without an interval of at least two days between their becoming members and their admission.
3. **Condition 3 in section 62(5)** – the club has at least 25 members.
4. **First condition in section 66(4)** –
 - a) the institute is managed by a committee or board, and
 - b) at least two thirds of the committee or board consists –
 - (i) partly of persons appointed or nominated, or appointed or elected from among persons nominated, by one or more licensed operators within the meaning of the Coal Industry Act 1994 (c.21), and

- (ii) partly of persons appointed or nominated, or appointed or elected from among persons nominated, by one or more organisations representing persons employed in or about coal mines.

5. Second condition in section 66(5) –

- a) the institute is managed by a committee or board, but
- b) the making of an appointment or nomination falling within subsection (4)(b)(i) or (4)(b)(ii) of the first condition is not practicable or would not be appropriate, and
- c) at least two thirds of the committee or board consists –
 - (i) partly of persons employed, or formerly employed, in or about coal mines
 - (ii) partly of persons appointed by the Coal Industry Social Welfare Organisation or a body or person to which the functions of that Organisation have been transferred under section 12(3) of the Miners' Welfare Act 1952 (c.23)

6. Condition 3 in section 62(4) – the club is established and conducted in good faith as a club.

7. Condition 5 in section 62(6) – alcohol is not supplied, or intended to be supplied, to members on the premises otherwise than by or on behalf of the club.

8. Additional condition 1 in section 64(2) – (so far as not managed by the club in general meeting or otherwise by the general body of members) the purchase of alcohol for the club, and the supply of alcohol by the club, are managed by a committee whose members –

- a) are members of the club
- b) have attained the age of 18 years; and
- c) are elected by the members of the club.

This subsection is subject to section 65 (which makes special provision for industrial and provident societies, friendly societies etc)

9. Additional condition 2 in section 64(3) – no arrangements are, or are intended to be, made for any person to receive at the expense of the club any commission, percentage or similar payment on, or with reference to, purchases of alcohol by the club.

10. Additional condition 3 in section 64(4) – no arrangements are, or are intended to be, made for any person directly or indirectly to derive any pecuniary benefit from the supply of alcohol by or on behalf of the club to members or guests, apart from –

- a) any benefit accruing to the club as a whole, or
- b) any benefit which a person derives indirectly by reason of the supply giving rise or contributing to a general gain from the carrying on of the club.
