**8. MOTIONS ON NOTICE**

In accordance with paragraph 11.1 of Part 4 (Rules of Procedure) of the Constitution, Members will be asked to consider the following motion from Councillors Williamson, Wainwright, Blyth, Linden and Jeal:-

"This Council recognising that should Norwich City Council be granted Unitary Status on extended boundaries, this will have implications for the rest of Norfolk. The Ministers' statement when announcing the unitary decisions said that the review was not just about a unitary solution for Norwich, but unitary solutions for the whole of Norfolk. Since this will be the direction to the Boundary Committee then the status quo (ie a continuation of two tier arrangements outside of a greater Norwich) will not be an option. This Council calls upon the Managing Director and the Leader of the Council to explore a unitary option for Great Yarmouth including a Great Yarmouth and Waveney Unitary Council to bring both authorities together."
