GREAT YARMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

BYELAW

Made under the Provisions of Section 9 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, by the Borough Council of Great Yarmouth with respect to the exclusion of dogs from children's play areas on certain housing estates.

1. No person in charge of a dog shall cause allow permit or suffer the dog to enter or remain in any of the children's play areas which are specified in the Schedule to this byelaw.
2. For the purposes of this byelaw the owner of the dog shall be deemed in charge thereof, unless the Court is satisfied that at the time when the dog entered, was in or was allowed permitted or suffered to remain in the children's play area it had been placed in or taken into the charge of some other person.
3. Any person offending against this byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds.
