

INVITATION TO A COMMUNITY EXHIBITION ON THE FUTURE OF SCRATBY AND CALIFORNIA

In areas likely to be affected by physical changes to the coast the Council has to designate a **Coastal Change Management Area**. This will set out how to deal with the predicted loss of coastline and where to relocate affected properties on roll-back land. The ideas overleaf are a start, put together by a group of local residents with officers and members from the Borough and Parish Councils and local businesses and groups, including members of the Scratby Coastal Erosion Group.

We now want the whole community to help with this very important issue. The ideas shown here will be open for discussion at a **Community Exhibition** to be held at the Information Centre on the car park on Rottenstone Lane on Friday 26 November 2.00 – 8.30pm and Saturday 27 November, 9.30 – 1.30.

We hope you will come and take part by giving us your views.
