COUNTY BOROUGH OF GREAT YARMOUTH

BYELAW

Made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Great Yarmouth, acting by the Council of the said County Borough.

The Byelaw described in the Schedule hereto is hereby repealed.

SCHEDULE

Byelaw made in pursuance of the Local Government Act 1858 and the Markets and Fairs Clauses Act 1847, incorporated therewith by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the (then) Borough of Great Yarmouth acting by the Council with respect to the prohibition of sale of salt-water fish; the byelaws being given as under the seal of the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the (then) Borough of Great Yarmouth and allowed at the Court of Quarter sessions for the said Borough of Great Yarmouth on the Ninth day of October 1862 and confirmed by Her Majesty's Secretary of State for the Home Department on the Thirteenth day of November 1862.
