BYELAW

made by the Great Yarmouth Borough Council in pursuance of Section 83 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907 in relation to the restriction of vehicles on Seafront Promenades.

* * * * *

1. No person shall, on any part of the promenades described in Schedules 1 and 2 of this Byelaw, ride or drive any mechanically propelled vehicle, motorcycle, bicycle, or other machine on such promenades at any time.
2. Provided that this Byelaw shall not apply to any person riding or driving any vehicle, motorcycle, bicycle or other machine, otherwise than to the obstruction or danger of any other person using the promenades,
 - (a) for the purpose of collecting refuse, or for any purpose connected with the maintenance or repair of the promenade or sea defence works
 - (b) in any emergency in connection with the saving of life
 - (c) for the purpose of transporting goods and equipment to or from any premises abutting the lengths of promenade described in Schedule 2
 - (d) crossing the promenades to use the various slipways in connection with the movement of boats to and from the Beach.
3. Provided that this Byelaw shall not be deemed to prohibit the driving or riding of any machine specially designed and used solely for the conveyance of an invalid.
4. Provided that this Byelaw shall not be deemed to prohibit the riding of pedal cycles during the period from 1st October to 30th April.
5. Provided that this Byelaw shall not be deemed to prohibit the riding or driving of any vehicle on the lengths of the promenade the subject of this Byelaw by any Police Officer in the course of his duties.
6. Any person contravening this Byelaw shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £50 in respect of each offence.

7. The Byelaw made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the former Great Yarmouth County Borough on 25th January, 1965 with reference to the Lower Esplanade at Gorleston, and confirmed by the Secretary of State on 12th April, 1965, is hereby repealed.

SCHEDULE 1

- (i) All and every part of the Sea Wall Promenade at Great Yarmouth from its commencement off North Drive opposite the junction with Salisbury Road, southwards to its termination at the Harbour's Mouth.
- (ii) All and every part of the Sea Wall promenade at Gorleston, from its commencement at the south pier of the Harbour's Mouth near the Spur breakwater, and running southwards to its termination at a point east of Cliff Lane.

SCHEDULE 2

- (i) All and every part of the roadway at Gorleston known as the Lower Esplanade, between the Sea Wall promenade and the foot of the cliffs.
- (ii) All and every part of the roadway known as "The Ravine", running from Marine Parade, Gorleston to the Lower Esplanade.
